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

PSU's impact in Oregon: \$1.5 billion



economic impact was over \$1.52 billion dollars in FY18.1 PSU graduates have an enormous economic impact on the region, as around 66% of PSU resident graduates and 29% of non-resident graduates from the 2008-2009 cohort remain in Oregon, investing their energy, skills, talents, and tax dollars in the state.

PSU is also a top-ten employer, providing over 7,000 family wage jobs (762 employees have a Doctorate or other terminal degree) to employees who contributed \$14.2 million in employer-based taxes to pay for local and state services in FY18. According to the annual NAFSA Association of International Educators' report on student spending, international students who attended PSU in 2019-20 contributed \$59.8 million to the regional economy.


Oregon HECC (2021)














PSU Students by Residency (Fall 2022)




Oregon Educational Attainment by Race/Ethnicity - Bachelor's degree or higher (2016/2021 ACS 5-year)








Average percentage of PSU graduates employed in Oregon by degree level by year(s) after degree awarded (Degrees obtained between AY2012-2013 to 2021-2022)

PSU graduates with bachelor's degrees in Oregon (w/no concurrent enrollment)






Preliminary Data – PSU Research Expenditures




Next steps
