Overview – Seattle Metro Trade

Seattle Metro Exports

- 2024: Value of Seattle metro exports = \$40 billion – declined 37% in the past 10 years
- The largest 2024 exports for the area were aircraft planes, electrical machinery, other machinery, oil seeds and grains
- Seattle metro exports were going to China at \$6.2 billion (15.5% of the total) in 2024 and the next 5 countries with the largest value of exports from Seattle are also Asian countries


Seattle Metro Imports

- 2024: Value of Seattle metro imports = \$74 billion & rose 25% since a low in 2020
- 2024: Seattle metro's top imports were autos, machinery, electrical machinery, toys, footwear & furniture
- Seattle metro imports were coming from China at \$18.5 billion, 25% of total imports
 - Seattle imports from China consist of machinery, toys, furniture and plastics

Seattle District Export Values Have Been in Decline Since 2015


35 Years of Seattle District Exports

Seattle Metro Export Values: 20+ Years of History





2024 Seattle Metro Exports - By Country**



35 Years of Seattle District Imports



Seattle Metro Import Values: 20+ Years of History



Value of Seattle Metro Imports Since 2003



The Global Complexity of Assembling a 737 in the United States

The Boeing 737: MADE IN AMERICA BUT GLOBALLY SOURCED

The global supply chain for American aircraft manufacturing is complex, with many parts imported from around the world.

While Boeing airplanes are assembled in the United States, they are built from thousands of components sourced from at least two dozen countries.

From raw materials to passenger seating and flight deck avionics, the entire plane is a global collaboration that relies on international partnerships.






Declining Export Values Since 2015


Seattle Metro Aircraft Industry Exports In Decline



Potential Tariff Impacts

Trade Policies / Effect on Inflation

- Across the board retaliatory tariffs are paused for 90 days until July
- 25% steel and aluminum tariffs are on
- Trading partners like Canada and China have retaliated with their own increase in tariffs but negotiations are ongoing
- Import tariff will increase prices for certain goods but the widespread nature and severity of the impact is still unknown

U.S. Industries Most Sensitive to Tariffs From Trading Partners

- Electronic products (i.e. Computer, semiconductor & circuit and communications equipment)
- Aerospace
- Auto manufacturing
