What is SPI?

- The Consumer Price Index (CPI) is a measure of the average change over time in the prices paid by urban consumers for a market basket of consumer goods and services.
- The Student Price Index (SPI) is a Student Lead Research initiative at CWU since 2020 that lets you view this measure with a student perspective.
 - Relatable to College Purchasing Habits
 - CWU Students' Cost of Living

How Does SPI Work?



Data collection is obtained via survey sent out to students in order to create a basket of goods. 100 questions - Item Weights





Collect prices monthly for basket created.

Annual Inflation Rates















Coffee


